

Literacy

Children will:

- Develop their handwriting skills and apply the cursive joins in written work.
- Apply known spelling patterns and commonly used words to all written work.
- Begin to use a greater variety of adjectives and descriptive phrases through personal writing.
- Develop their reading evaluation skills through the context of a novel study (James and the Giant Peach).
- Share personal stories orally and listen to the experiences of others.
- Develop their reading fluency, comprehension and expression.

Context for Learning— Climate and Weather

Children will:

Explore climate zones around the world and compare and describe how climate affects living things.

Numeracy and Maths

Children will:

- Investigate how whole numbers are constructed, understand the importance of zero within the system and can use their knowledge to explain the link between a digit, its place and its value.
- Explore a variety of ways in which data is presented and can ask and answer questions about the information it contains.
- Use a range of ways to collect information and can sort it in a logical, organised and imaginative way.

In Primary 4, skills knowledge and understanding are developed through a range of teaching and learning opportunities including direct teaching, targeted group time and tailored learning areas in the classroom and outdoor environment.
