Learning Intentions

Literacy: Talking

We will be continuing our learning to:

- develop our critical literacy skills with character analysis
- summarise short fiction/non fiction texts

- Clearly setting out the main points of the argument
- Using topic sentences to start paragraphs
- Including information to support my argument
- Using persuasive language
- Summing up the main argument at the end.

Numeracy and Maths

We will be learning to:

- develop our subtraction, multiplication and division skills
- further develop our speed of recall of the times tables
- develop further, our knowledge and skills with 12 and 24 hour clocks and converting between analogue and digital time
- develop our understanding of perimeter and area.

Health and Wellbeing

We will be learning:

- about the different ways that we can respond to challenges and setbacks
- to create our own Passport to Learning e.g. What helps us learn and What stops us learning.
