Literacy

Through our context for learning, pupils will:

- plan and deliver a presentation which is well organised, has a logical structure and is relevant to the task.
- continue to make reference to the text in order to demonstrate their understanding of what they have read.
- plan and create their own texts; making accurate use of grammar and punctuation.
- plan and create their own texts; showing a greater understanding of genre.

Through daily literacy activities, pupils will:

- develop their handwriting skills, reading skills and awareness of spelling/phonic patterns.
- develop their understanding of grammar and sentence structure, with a focus on more complex punctuation, self correction and making improvements.

Numeracy and Mathematics

The pupils will:

- continue to develop a range of counting and calculation skills; building on their understanding of addition and subtraction.
- continue to develop their understanding of percentages.
- continue to develop their understanding of money.
- apply their understanding of numeracy and maths into a range of problem solving contexts.

Health and Wellbeing

Pupils will apply their understanding of what it means to be resilient, throughout all aspects of their learning.

In PE, pupils will continue develop their coordination, fluency, rhythm and timing through social dance; as well as their respect and tolerance towards others. Pupils will also develop core strength and flexibility through yoga.

The pupils will continue to develop their awareness of the outdoor environment and how it can support their physical, social and emotional wellbeing.
