# **Literacy**

#### Children will:

- Further develop using full stops and capital letters in more than one sentence.
- Develop their use of other punctuation when appropriate.
- Develop personal writing including saying how they feel.
- Listen to and identify the main events from a story or personal experience.
- Identify vowels and constantans.
- Understand the terms plural and singular.
- Continue to develop their spelling through practising their tricky words and spelling patterns.
- Develop their use of expression
- Practice the weather and seasons in French

# Context for Learning—Food and Farming

In Primary 2, skills knowledge and understanding are developed through a range of teaching and learning opportunities including direct teaching, targeted group time and tailored learning areas in the classroom and outdoor environment.

#### Children will:

- Understand things humans do have an impact on the world.
- Understand that by making small changes to the way we live can make a big difference to the environment.

#### In PE children will:

- Develop their running, jumping and throwing skills through athletics.
