#### **Care Plan Review**

The children's individual care plans need to be reviewed 6 monthly, therefore the children who attended ELC last year are due a review. This should only take a short discussion with your child's keyworker. The review requires a parent/carer to read over the documents you have already submitted and update any details that may have changed or add any additional information. Your child's keyworker will organise a time either at the beginning or end of a session that suits you to be able discuss. If you are unable to come in to ELC we will send you a copy home for you to look over, sign and hand back in to a member if staff.

## Library

Each week we encourage parents/carers to help their child choose a library book from the ELC library basket. The library basket will be kept beside the book nook next to the cloakroom door. Children can change their library books as often as they like. We ask that parent/carers keep their child's library record up to date, marking the borrowed books designated number in and out in the columns provided. The children's library records can be found within the blue folder kept with the library basket. Attached to this letter you will find a sheet to fill in with your child each time you share a story together. Please write in the name of the book and, after discussion with your child; exploring events, characters, likes and dislikes, please could you fill in the comment box with your child's thoughts on the book.

# **Parent Helpers**

On the information board in the cloakroom area we have rotas for the experiences that we require parent/carer support to enable us to provide the experience. The children visit the shops in the local community to buy our snack for the next again week. Unfortunately we are unable to provide these learning opportunities if we don't have the correct adult/child ratio for both our walk to the shops and within the ELC. If you are available for 30/40 minutes at the beginning of a session to accompany us to the shops please write your name next to the date of availability.

# **Enrolment for Early Learning and Childcare for session 2019/20**

Enrolment for ELC (nursery) for session 2019/20 will take place between Monday 14th to Friday 18th January 2019. Application packs will be issued to our existing ELC3 children. A copy of your child's birth certificate and proof of residence e.g. a driving licence, utility bill is required to be presented at the time of enrolment.

# **Literacy Information Evening**

Parents/carers of pupils in Early Learning and Childcare (ELC) and Primary 1 are invited to a literacy information evening on Monday 21 January 2019. This will be an opportunity for staff to share literacy approaches used at Melrose ELC and Primary school and ideas on how to support your child's development within the four developmental continua; concepts of print, phonological awareness, oral language and fine motor skills.

Parent/Carer consultations with your child's Early Learning and Childcare key worker will be taking place on **Monday 25 February and Tuesday 26 February.** 

Each appointment will last 10 minutes.

A sign-up sheet is available in the ELC cloakroom to enable parent/carers to select an appropriate time for their consultation. If you are unable to come into ELC to sign up for an appointment please contact the school office who will make the arrangements for you.

The discussion during the consultation meeting will be based on your child's strengths and development needs in key areas including the level of support required. You may be given suggestions for ways you can support learning at home.

#### Clothing

The outdoors is regularly used for learning. Please ensure that your child has suitable clothes, a coat and outdoor shoes. On wet days please send your child to ELC with wellies. Children are encouraged to be independent and, where possible, should be sent with shoes they can fasten and unfasten independently.

Melrose ELC would like to offer parents/carers an opportunity to order an ELC jumper and t-shirt for the children to wear when they are busy learning through play. If you would like to place an order please ask a member of staff for details.

#### **Snack Money**

The children have snack every day through which healthy eating is promoted. In the cloakroom there is a snack menu for the week and a list of snack costs. Children are given the opportunity to suggest healthy snack ideas and try new foods. Snack is priced at £0.50 per day. You will be informed of the total cost of snack for your child each term (holidays and in-service days will be taken into account). Payment should be given to a member of staff. Cheques should be made payable to "Melrose Primary School" and cash in an envelope marked with the child's name. A receipt will be written and placed in your child's pocket.

Snack money for this term is now due.
