Resilient Schools

Resilient Schools is a system set up by SBC which aims to keep as many schools as possible open in bad weather. Resilient Schools is activated in the event of severe weather affecting the whole of the Scottish Borders. The decision is made centrally usually when the conditions are such that it is not advisable to drive. Parents/carers will receive a text message to tell them that Resilient Schools has been activated. Information will also be available on the SBC website, SBC Facebook, SBC twitter and Radio Borders.

Melrose Primary School will have enough teachers and support staff to safely meet the needs of pupils in Primaries 1 to 7, the ELC provision will **not** be open during Resilient Schools. Only children who normally walk to school should attend school, school transport will not run. If your child is ill or you choose not to send them due to the weather conditions please let the school know not to expect them.
