Children in Need Friday 15 November 2019

There will be prizes for the most colourful costume in each class - judged by the Fundraisers.

Scholastic Book Fair

A book fair will be running during the week commencing 18^{th} November 2019. Children will get the opportunity to visit the fair with their class and it will be open for parents during the above consultations (Monday 12^{th} 4.30pm - 6.30pm, Wednesday 14^{th} 4pm - 6pm and Thursday 15^{th} 3.45pm- 5.45pm).

Please take note; it will **not** be open either before or after school.

Enrolment for Early Learning and Childcare (ELC) for session 2020/21

Enrolment for ELC for session 2020/21 will take place from **Monday 18th to Friday 22nd November 2019**. Children born between 1st March 2016 and 28th February 2017 are invited to apply for a 4 year old place and children born between 1st March 2017 and 28th February 2018 are invited to apply for a 3 year old place. Children who currently have a three year old place in our ELC setting or are enrolled to start before February 2020 must re-enrol for session 2020/2021.

Application packs will be issued to our existing ELC3 children. A copy of your child's full birth certificate and proof of residence (acceptable proof – utility bill, bank statement, driving licence, child benefit letter or council tax bill) is required to be presented at the time of enrolment.

From August 2020 Melrose Primary School ELC will provide 1140 funded hours for all children. We have requested a change to the conditions within our registration with Care Inspectorate to enable us to increase the number of children within our ELC at any one time. We are also working on plans to expand the use of outdoor learning within the school grounds/our Outdoor Learning Zone for ELC children. The timings of the sessions for 2020/2021 are similar to the school day timings.

Enrolment for Primary One for session 2020/21

Enrolment for primary one for session 2018/19 will take place between **Monday 18th and Friday 22nd November 2019**. Application packs will be issued to our existing nursery children. A copy of your child's full birth certificate and proof of residence (acceptable proof – utility bill, bank statement, driving licence, child benefit letter or council tax bill) is required to be presented at the time of enrolment.

Those who live out with the Melrose Primary School catchment area are asked to enrol their child at the catchment school appropriate for their home address, also complete and return a placing request form to Melrose Primary School. Failure to enrol at the catchment school will mean the placing request form for your child <u>will not</u> be considered by Scottish Borders Council.

It is very important that children are enrolled during enrolment week, in ELC and school, as the numbers are used to determine staffing and classes for 2020/2021.

Families who live **out with** the catchment area for Earlston High School and wish a child to be enrolled at Earlston High School must complete a placing request form to be received by Earlston High School as soon as possible but **no later than 28**th **February 2020**. Placing request forms are available from Earlston High School.

Children who live **within** Earlston High School catchment area will receive information packs and enrolment forms in the summer term. Further information is also available for children transferring to secondary school using the above link.
