

## **Literacy**

Children will:

- Develop their writing skills including handwriting, and appropriate punctuation.
- Develop their spelling skills including 'Tricky words' and spelling patterns with a focus on vowel digraphs.
- Understand and use nouns, verbs and adjectives correctly in their writing.
- Develop writing based on research, stating facts and using headings and diagrams.
- Continue to develop their fluency and expression when reading aloud.
- Begin looking for nouns, verbs and adjectives in texts.
- Share their thoughts, about what they have listened to or watched, with others.
- Begin to name some of their body parts in French.

## **Health and Wellbeing**

Children will:

- Understand that being active is good for my body and mind.
- Recognise hobbies and interests that make them feel good.
- Understand that trying something new involves taking a risk.

In PE children will:

- Develop their gymnastic skills including a variety of travelling, rolling, balancing and jumping.
- Link a series of actions and skills to create movement patterns and sequences .

## **Context for Learning—My Senses and My Body**

The children will be exploring their senses and how their body works and grows through a variety of activities.

**In Primary 2, skills knowledge and understanding are developed through a range of teaching and learning opportunities including direct teaching, targeted group time and tailored learning areas in the classroom and outdoor environment.**

## **Numeracy and Maths**

Children will:

- Continue to develop a range of counting and calculation skills (including addition, subtraction, division and multiplication)
- Continue to build a quick and accurate recall of number facts.
- Develop their knowledge on fractions by finding equal parts of a whole.
- Find fractions of amounts through sharing and counting.

How you can help at home...

*Explore and discuss their senses.*

*Discuss germs and the importance of handwashing and hygiene*

*Talk about when they were babies and discuss how they have changed and developed.*

*Share books and use different voices for different characters.*

### **Home Learning**

*Regularly practise 'Learn its' from the homework sheets.*

*Regularly practise 'Tricky word' spellings from the homework sheets.*

*Listen to your child read aloud from their reading book and discuss what they have read.*
