Literacy

The children will:

- Continue to develop their writing skills including sentence structure, punctuation and handwriting
- Continue to develop their spelling skills including common words and spelling patterns.
- Begin to develop their understanding of fact and opinion.
- Continue to develop their understanding of what they read through asking and answering a range of questions.
- Explore and create a range of texts with a particular focus on both poetry and non-fiction texts.

Numeracy and Mathematics

The children will:

- Continue to develop a range of counting and calculation skills and build on quick and accurate recall of number facts.
- Further develop their understanding of time.
- Further develop their understanding of fractions.

Health and Wellbeing

Through the Building Resilience programme, pupils will learn about the importance of relationships and why good relationships are a two-way thing. We will explore strategies for making and maintaining friendships.

In PE, pupils will continue to develop their fitness, stamina and resilience; as well as their aiming, dribbling, throwing and catching skills.

The children will continue to develop their knowledge of the outdoor environment and how it can support their wellbeing.
