Poppy Scotland Appeal

Primary 7 pupils will be selling poppies in school from Wednesday 1st November 2017 until Wednesday 15th November 2017. If you would like your child to support this appeal, please send them into school with a donation. All monies raised will go to the Royal British Legion Poppy Scotland Appeal 2017. Primary 7 pupils will be representing Melrose Primary School at the Remembrance Service at the War Memorial on Sunday 12th November 2017; all pupils and families are invited to attend.

Book Fair

A book fair will be in school for the week commencing 6th November 2017. Children will have the opportunity to visit the book fair, with their class during the week. During the times of the parent/carer/teacher consultations the Fair will also be open, in main office, for the purchase of books.

Outdoor Play

Children will be outside learning and at break times in all but extremely inclement weather. This includes the use of the Green Space (the grass adjacent to the school playground) which can at time be quite muddy. We request that children come to school with appropriate clothing, including jacket, <u>and</u> footwear.

Flu Inoculations

Reminder that flu inoculations will take place in Melrose Primary School on Thursday 16th November and Friday 17 November 2017.

Norovirus – Winter Vomiting Bug

Children **should not return to school or ELC for 48 hours** after the last bout of sickness and/or diarrhoea. Compliance with this recommendation will avoid unnecessary spread of the virus.

Huntly Road

Despite constant requests Huntly Road is still be used by some parents/carers as a drop off/pick up point. Huntly Road is a designated safe route to school; this was established as a safe walking area based on the presence of sidewalks, walking paths and the location of crosswalks. The designated parking areas, drop off and pick up points, for Melrose Primary School and Nursery are St Mary's Road, the Health Centre and Melrose Rugby club car park.

Drivers who use Huntly Road at the beginning and end of a school day are putting children's lives at risk. There have been a number of near misses/incidents where pupils have narrowly avoided being injured by cars. We request that Huntly Road is NOT used for parking, drop off or pick up at any time when children are in school.

Enrolment for Primary One for session 2018/19

Enrolment for primary one for session 2016/17 will take place between **20th and 24th November 2017**. Application packs will be issued to our existing nursery children. A copy of your child's birth certificate and proof of residence e.g. a driving licence, utility bill is required to be presented at the time of enrolment.

Those who live out with the Melrose Primary School catchment area are asked to enrol their child at the catchment school appropriate for their home address, also complete and return a placing request form to Melrose Primary School. Failure to enrol at the catchment school will mean the placing request form for your child <u>will not</u> be considered by Scottish Borders Council.

Enrolment for ELC will take place in January 2018 – further details will be issued in due course.
