

Primary 7 Teaching and Learning Overview - Term 2: October - December 2021

In Primary 7 skills, knowledge and understanding are developed through a range of teaching and learning opportunities. These include direct teaching, group work and a variety of independent and cooperative learning activities and experiences.

Learning Intentions

Literacy – Reading, Writing, Talking & Listening

Context: Poetry

We will be learning:

- to analyse a range of poems, commenting on figurative language (imagery) structure and theme.
- to apply learned techniques to create poems

Numeracy

We will be learning to:

- select the most appropriate strategies to solve a range of calculations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division)

Maths

Context: Fractions & Percentages

We will be learning:

- how to calculate percentages and fractions of a quantity
- how to show the equivalent forms of fraction and decimal fractions
- how to compare and order fractions
- how to express fractions in their simplest form

Health and Wellbeing

Learning Context: Building Resilience – Keep Connected

We will be learning:

- that relationships are important for our health and wellbeing
- that belonging to a group can be a good way to build friendships
- skills that help us build friendships and work well in groups

Learning Context: Zones of Regulation

We will be learning:

- coping strategies we can use to help us regulate our emotions

P7D PE - Learning Context: Creative Dance

We will be learning:

- to create and present dance
- respond to our dance experience

P7K PE - Learning Context: Yoga & Mental Well-being

We will be learning:

- about the importance of maintaining good mental health
- to apply movement skills accurately and with control
