Parent/carer update 6: 27th of August 2020

Our priority over the next few weeks is ensuring that our learners are safe and happy. As Covid-19 is still a risk we have introduced a number of measures and changes that will increase the safety of all - parent/carers, staff and learners.

Please take time to read the information below and help by supporting us with any changes to normal operating procedures that we are requesting.

P.E Days – Wet weather planning

Scottish Government advice continues to be that all P.E. takes place outside. The guidance also recognises the importance of P.E. for children's' Health and Wellbeing - schools are asked to continue to deliver learners' entitlement of two hours of P.E. per week.

Children are asked to come to school dressed for P.E. on the days they have P.E. As the weather is very changeable we ask that children have a change of clothing including footwear to change into if necessary.

- come to school dressed in P.E. kit on P.E. days
- bring a change of clothing (school uniform) including footwear, in a named bag

Staffing / class cover

Due to the increase in Covid 19 testing and the time test results are taking to be returned teachers who are not class committed are covering class teacher absence to allow us to keep the school operating as normal for our learners. Consequently staff who are covering teaching in class are not able to carry some of the jobs



that they would normally undertake. We will continue to do our best to keep the school functioning as normal, however we would appreciate your understanding and patience should we take longer to carry out certain jobs e.g. responding to e-mail queries, communicating by telephone etc.

Huntly Road – Please do not use this area for drop-offs and parking

Huntly Road is part of our 'safer routes to school'. There are a number of signs and road markings to mark out an area where it is not safe to park, drop off or pick up - 0800-1600. Please respect these markings in the interest of keeping children and young people safe. P1 parent/carers

Thank you for your support and understanding about the drop off and collection arrangements for P1 children. We also ask that once your child/ren have gone into class you leave the playground as soon as possible in support of our ongoing procedures to reduce the spread of infection. We encourage parents/carers to communicate with their child's class teacher however in the current circumstances this cannot be done face-to-face including at the classroom door.
