- develop our mental and written strategies to solve calculations with a variety of numbers including decimals and large numbers
- develop our speed of recall of the times tables
- tell the time using 12-hour clocks, realising there is a link with 24-hour notation
- use simple time periods to give a good estimate of how long a journey should take
