Learning Intentions**Literacy: Writing, Listening and Talking****Learning Context: Space and Science**

We will be learning to:

- consistently apply basic punctuation to written texts
- consistently apply known spelling rules to written texts
- understand the effect of, and apply, more complex punctuation in written texts
- include relevant ideas, knowledge and information in a text
- use an appropriate style and format to convey information
- review and correct our own writing
- plan and deliver a presentation with relevant content and appropriate structure

Reading

We will be learning to:

- demonstrate our understanding of a text by answering a range of questions
- develop strategies to support our comprehension of a text

French

We will be:

- recapping greetings, personal information, colours and numbers
- speaking, reading and writing phrases and sentences to develop these topics

Numeracy

We will be learning to:

- Select the most appropriate strategies to solve a range of calculations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division)

Maths

Context: Time

We will be learning to:

- read and record time in both 12 hour and 24 hour notations and convert between the two
- use and interpret timetables, schedules and calendars to plan events, calculate durations and solve real life problems
- use simple time periods to give a good estimate of how long a journey should take

Health and Wellbeing

Learning Context: Building Resilience - Take a Moment & The Zones of Regulation

We will be learning:

- about the 4 zones of regulation
- to identify how we feel and that feelings are temporary (use the zones to recognise emotions)
- how emotions affect how we and others behave
- strategies to manage overwhelming feelings

Learning Context: Ball Skill - Hockey, football, team games

We will be learning to develop our:

- hockey skills - attack & defend principles, team play and evasion skills.
- Team work during play, throwing and catching skills, defending and attacking as part of a game
