Writing

- Apply features of a chosen genre
- Create interesting characters through, for example, their feelings and actions, physical description and/or dialogue
- Creates setting/context with some descriptive detail
- Attempt to use figurative language (imagery) to engage the reader
- Create plots with clear structures, for example, suitable opening, turning point, climax and/or satisfactory ending
- Use a range of punctuation, for example, capital letters, full stops, commas, inverted commas (speech marks), exclamation marks, question marks and/or apostrophes

Reading

• Respond to literal, inferential and evaluative questions on a range of given texts including supporting detail and evidence

Listening and Talking

- Communicate clearly, audibly and with expression
- Plan and deliver an organised presentation with relevant content and appropriate structure
- Use suitable vocabulary for purpose and audience
- Select and use resources to support communication

Numeracy & Maths

We will be learning to:

Apply mental and written strategies using the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division)

Learning Context: Properties of 2D Shape and 3D objects

- Identify and describe a wide variety of 2D and 3D shapes using specific vocabulary
- Understand the relationship between 3D objects and their nets

Learning Context: Angles

- Recognise and record angles in the environment, using appropriate mathematical vocabulary
- Measure, draw and calculate angles
