Forthcoming Parking Restrictions

There will be parking restrictions on St Mary's Road starting the 1st July for 15 weeks to allow suitable access for the construction of the new 3G pitch on the Greenyards. The following restrictions are to be put in place, with allowance for school drop off/pick up during term time:

Temporary Traffic Regulation Order out with school term (3rd July 2019 until 16th August 2019)

- No parking Monday to Friday

Temporary Traffic Regulation Order during school term (19th August 2019 until 11th October 2019):

- No parking Monday to Friday except:
 - 8.30 to 9.00 and 15.00 to 15.30 Mondays to Thursdays and;
 - 8.30 to 9.00 and 12.00 to 12.30 on Fridays.

There will also be restrictions in place for the Melrose Rugby Club car park at points during the works, however as this is related to Scottish Power works we cannot confirm these restrictions.
