Numeracy Progress





- Staff have been using Quality Improvement methods to target intervention groups. Allowing teachers to identify strategies that lead to improvement.
- Staff training on the analysis of National Standardised Assessment data allowing areas for development to be identified.
- Following data analysis staff training was provided on conceptual numeracy teaching of fractions.
- Staff trained in the use of Sumdog tools and assessments allowing tasks and assessments to be targeted to individuals.
- Learners are engaged in and enjoy using Sumdog as a tool for maths learning.
- Family maths event planned for Maths Week Scotland to highlight simple, fun activities to engage learners in maths and numeracy learning.

Writing Progress



- Writing standard created for infant and upper classes to ensure consistency across the school.
- Quality Improvement strategies used to improve tools for writing skills across the school. Staff given time with supporters to develop these approaches.
- Development of a 3 year planning cycle to teach new text types.
- All staff are now using the Fife Writing Assessment resource.
- Learners are showing greater understanding of the new text types and the features of them when creating texts.
