Forth Valley College run a unique STEM initiative that is open to all Primary 5-7 pupils from schools across the region (Falkirk Council, Stirling Council and Clackmannanshire Council). As part of this programme, pupils will work on a range of investigations, experiments and team activities with the Famous Four characters - Suzi the Scientist, Tim the Technologist, Eric the Engineer and Mandy the Mathematician. Topics covered include biodiversity, climate change, green energy, sustainability, planet earth and space, forces, rocket building and engineering challenges. Primary 5, 6 and 7 will all have this STEM experience in their classrooms for a full day in November.

Primary 1 are booked in to entertain the pensioners at a church coffee morning. This will give them a practice in front of an audience. They are sure to be a big hit.


Primary 1 & 2 Nativity


Busking for Strathcarron


Communication
