<u> House Captains – School Improvement Plan</u>

Children involved in choosing new House names last year, Latin names – more fitting with culture/ ethos at Antonine

Former P7 children involved in choosing new House Captains for this year in June 2022 School Improvement Plan shared by House Captains – children worked together to create posters to share our future plans with parents

- 1. Literacy 4k PEF money spent on Talk4Writing scheme, huge improvement in reading and writing results; library development reading is now a focus, with each class having their own 'reading spine'; spelling programmes to be reviewed along with handwriting
- 2. Developing the Young Workforce skills, career development, P5-7 will be using My World of Work skills based online programme with ideas for job being offered to children; Careers Fayre later in year; working on '7 habits' helping children to be the best they can be
- 3. Assessment & Differentiation—sharing learning targets for staff, awareness of levels—developing an assessment framework for school—what is the purpose of assessment

4. STEM – science, technologies, engineering, mathematics – HwB, topic approaches – gaps in Science etc, working alongside Bonnybridge primary – create progressive planners which incorporates all

Community Choices Grant

New basketball area has proved to be a huge success with children

Back area of school has been transformed – friendship club/ outdoor learning / nurture area

Cheque to be sent and finalised

Continue to add to this area – money used to buy loose parts play and provide opportunity for open ended play

Homework, attendance and uniform

Adapted homework based on feedback from parents last year

Run for around 6 months – then review

P1 and P2 – jotters – Teams to be introduced for little ones around October time, but jotters will still be used to complete tasks

Attendance – letters issued October – traffic lighted letters – between 90 – 95 % amber, below 90 % red

Uniform has been a huge success – continue to promote at assembly/ in school newsletters etc.
