A successful "Health Fortnight"

Last year when using a self-evaluation tool with the pupils they told us that they were keen to try new skills and sports in Health & Well-Being. Pupils also told staff that they didn't know as much about Mental Health and wanted to learn more. This focus then linked into the Rights Respecting Journey we are on as a school and "Health Fortnight" was imagined.

La2rence Fletcher, family support worker, managed to receive a successful bid of £1000 from Cash for Kids which we were able to use to fund the "Health Fortnight" experiences for the children and keep everything free.

Over the course of the two weeks, every single pupil in school took part in multiple workshops, skills-based learning and health activities all delivered from a very wide range of providers. Pupils were building resilience and challenging themselves.

Pupil and parent feedback has been extremely positive and there has been a positive impact on the children's knowledge and learning around their own Health & Well-Being.

It was a fantastic learning initiative to start Term 4 and we will continue to build on this learning.

Next Steps for our school

The pupil council has been devising a questionnaire for pupils and collecting responses. We are asking children about their learning, what they see as a priority for them and what they want to work on for our School Improvement Plan next year. The results from this will be shared at the next parent council meeting and will help to inform the school's next steps.

Our main means of communication is the newsletter and the school app – please check over carefully to ensure you are fully informed of news from school.


Twitter is used by classes to show some of what has been going on during the school day. No new information will be shared by Twitter.
