## Clothing

We have lots of fun at ELC but sometimes we can get messy and wet while we are learning. Although we do have some spare clothes we can provide children with, our supply is becoming limited. Could we please ask that all children bring a few changes of clothes with them to ELC? As we are outdoors learning every day, please feel free to leave these, along with welly boots at children's pegs if easier to do so.

## Sickness and Medication

We understand that there are times when your child may require medication if they have been under the weather. If your child requires medication to be administered whilst they are attending ELC, the medicine must have a prescription label and be accompanied with a medication form that can be collected from your child's key worker.
Similarly, if your child only receives medication at home, it is useful to alert your child's keyworker as it allows them to better support your child whilst in ELC. In the event that your child becomes unwell whilst in ELC, a member of staff will notify you or your emergency contact. Can we please ask that all parents/carers ensure that these contact details are up to date? Thank you.
On some occasions, illness can lead to the following exclusion periods:

- Sickness / Diarrhea - Children can return to ELC 48 hours after the last episode of sickness/diarrhea. High Temperature - Children can return once they no longer require medication to regulate their Temperature. ## Planned Outdoor Learning Programme

As you are aware outdoor experiences are a fundamental part of children's development. The outdoor environment promotes Health and Wellbeing, Literacy, Numeracy and Science, as well as introducing our children to lifelong skills they will use throughout their life. Exposure to outdoors builds resilience, confidence and independence and supports development of risk assessing skills.

As outdoor experiences are such an important learning opportunity we have developed an outdoor learning programme for our children. Our outdoor learning programme will consist of both visits to our fairy garden, which is within the school grounds and visits offsite around the local community. These planned outdoor experiences will take place in key groups with your child's keyworker leading the experience. To support us with delivering outdoor learning, can we please ask parents to provide welly boots or appropriate outdoor shoes that they don't mind getting muddy, appropriate clothing for the weather, an outdoor jacket and a change of clothes. We will provide children with a waterproof suit or waterproof trousers and light jacket
