School Enrolment

If your child is due to start Primary 1 in August 2023, you will have now received an email from the centre to enrol your child into your catchment school. Please ensure that you complete the enrolment process by 31.12.22. If your child's enrolment involves a placing request, you wil have to enrol with the name of your catchment school before completing a placing request form. Similarly, if you wish for your child to have an adiditional year at ELC, please ensure that you complete the form, Request for Deferred Year. If you have any questions regarding this, please speak to Nicola.

Bringing snacks and juice from home

We understand that children like to bring a water bottle to ELC, however due to allergies and medical conditions of children within our setting, can we please request that children refrain from bringing juice and snacks in their bags. During the ELC session, children are offered both a morning and afternoon snack in addition to the lunch provided. In the event of any child not liking the food on offer, we always do our best to find them an alternative. Milk is offered at all snack and lunch times, while water is on offer throughout the ELC day.

Sickness and Absence

When you child is unwell, there are times when they should not attend ELC. For example with vomiting/diarrhea there is a 48 hour exclusion policy from the last episode. If your child has a high temperature only, they are able to return to ELC when this has returned to normal. We are aware that there are times when your child may require medication before attending ELC. If this is the case, can we please request that a member of ELC staff is informed as this ensures that staff are fully aware and able to meet your child's needs, especially in the event of an emergency situation.
