Our school car park continues to be a very busy place. It works well when drivers do not double park or block a clear route around the central road section. In working alongside the Parent Council the Pupil Council have designed safe driving and parking posters to be displayed around the car park. These have been funded by the Parent Council. These will be displayed in the coming weeks once they have been printed.

There is a particularly large poster which has been designed for the main gates. There are consistent complaints about cars/vans/trucks blocking pedestrian access through the main gate. Children need to walk around parked cars at the gate entrance to gain entry to the playground from the car park which is extremely dangerous. Please keep the entrance area of the gate clear for everyone's safety.

The 7 Habits of Happy Children

As part of our schools Health & Well-Being approach the assembly programme has been encouraging P3-P7 pupils to learn healthy habits to make their learning more effective. The key to this approach is encouraging pupils to take more responsibility for their own work ethic and drive. Pupils have been very positive so far and we even have a fantastic song that we sing at assembly to remind us.
