
Welcome Back

Junk Modelling

We can accept

- Boxes

We cannot accept:

- Egg cartons
- Mayonnaise or salad cream bottles
- Coleslaw tubs
- Tubs that have contained dips
- Toilet roll tubes
- Milk cartons

- Old Greetings cards
- Postcards
- Used tissue boxes
- Supermarket magazines, toy catalogues

Outdoor Learning

Outdoor play is an integral part of the ELC day. As children are outdoors in all weather, they can, at times, become a bit messy. Can we therefore, please ask that all children bring with them a suitable outdoor jacket, welly boots and a change of clothes? Can we also request that all items of clothing please be clearly labelled with your child's name?

Setting the Table

From August 2025 we will be following new guidance shared from Scottish Government - Setting the Table. This guidance provides ELC and catering staff with information of how best to provide nutritious snacks and meals for our children. Our ELC lunch menu has changed and there is no longer a cold option for children to choose. Children have been enjoying the hot option and ELC staff will always provide an alternative from the larder if children require this. Food from home

Can we please ask that children do not bring any snacks to ELC in their bag? We have children both in ELC and school who have severe allergies which can be life threatening. Children often like to share things with their friends and find it difficult to leave snacks in their bag until home time. By not bringing snacks to ELC it supports staff in limiting the risk to our children. Thank you in advance.



Drop Off and Pick Up

Our ELC hours are between 8.45am and 2.45pm. Parents and carers are encouraged to accompany children into the ELC playroom where they will be greeted by children's keyworkers. All children should be both signed in and out using the registers provided. In the afternoon, the main ELC door will be open from 2.30pm with all children requiring to be collected by 2.45pm. Whilst we appreciate that unforeseen circumstances can happen, causing plans to change last minute, we kindly ask that you contact the ELC at the earliest opportunity to notify them of any changes.

Reporting to Parents/Carers

At Antonine ELC, we are committed to working alongside our parents and carers to ensure all children have a positive learning experience. We recognise that it is essential that we regularly share information regarding children's learning with our families. Below is an overview of the different ways in which we report to parents/carers throughout the session:

Settling in	Around 6 weeks after a child joins Antonine ELC, their family is given the opportunity to

Children's	All children within Antonine ELC have a Learning Journal. These are personal to the child	
Learning	and include all information relevant to children's learning. Staff regularly add

	These are stored within the playroom so children and families can access these whenever

My Progress at	All families will receive a brief evaluation of their child's learning at the end of each term.	
Antonine ELC	Children who have recently joined Antonine ELC and have not yet completed a full term	
	will not receive this until the following term.	



Absence Procedure

Can we please ask all parents/carers to inform us if your child will be absent from ELC. This can be done via either email antonineprimaryschool@education.falkirk.sch.uk or telephone 01324 503140. We understand that there are times when your child may require medication if they have been under the weather. If your child requires medication to be administered whilst they are attending ELC, the medicine must have a prescription label and be accompanied with a medication form that can be collected from your child's key worker. Similarly, if your child only receives medication at home, it is useful to alert your child's

keyworker as it allows them to better support your child whilst in ELC. In the event that your child becomes unwell whilst in ELC, a member of staff will notify you or your emergency contact. Can we please ask that all parents/carers ensure that these contact details are up to date?
