Entry and Exit Points

As it is our first week back we have been monitoring the entry and exit points at the start and end of the day. As our families safety is paramount, can we please ask that our families now adhere to the following guidance:

- Zone 2 families who enter through the main ELCC door should now queue round through the gate that leads into to the playground.
- Zone 1 parents continue to enter through the garden gate and queue in the ELCC garden.

We hope that this will help to ease the congestion at drop off and pick up times.

Communication

Just a reminder that if any information about your child has changed including address, phone number, dietary or medical needs can you please ensure that you update staff as soon as possible.



We understand that due to current circumstances, it is very difficult to chat with your child's keyworker. However, if there is anything you would like to discuss please do not hesitate to email or call us. A meeting via telephone can be arranged for a time that is most convenient for you.

Outdoor Programme

As you are aware outdoor experiences are a fundamental part of children's development. The outdoor environment promotes health and wellbeing, literacy, numeracy and science, as well as introducing our children to lifelong skills they will use throughout their life. Exposure to outdoors builds resilience, confidence and independence and supports developing risk assessing skills.



As outdoor experiences are such an important opportunity for our children to participate in we have developed an outdoor learning programme. Our outdoor learning programme will consist of both visits to our fairy garden, which is within the school grounds and visits offsite around the local community. 
