#### **Session Times**

Our ELC session times are 8.45am to 2.45pm. We open the doors at 8.45am and operate a soft pick-up where the doors open from 2.30pm. From 8.55am onwards, all staff are supporting children with their learning. This means that any children arriving after this time can be dropped off to a staff member at the main ELC door. This not only ensures the safety of all children, it minimises disruption to children's learning.





#### Learning Interests

Children are currently showing a significant interest in the weather, monster trucks and messy play such as gloop, playdough and shaving foam. We also currently have lots of young bakers in ELC, who are enjoying using our new bread maker on a daily basis.

#### Clothing

We enjoy learning in lots of different ways at ELC. Sometimes we can get messy and wet when learning especially outdoors. Although we do have some spare clothes we can provide children with, our supply is becoming

limited. Could we please ask that all children bring a few changes of clothes with them to ELC? As we are outdoors learning every day, please feel free to leave these, along with welly boots at children's pegs if easier to do so.

#### Bikes

Many children are showing an interest in cycling and loving bringing their bicyles to ELC. Whilst we are so happy to see the children developing their cycling skills, we are unfortunately unable to store these in our cloakroom. We are loking into purchasing a bicycle rack for outside our ELC door and hope this is in place soon.



#### **Sickness and Medication**

We understand that there are times when your child may require medication if they have been under the weather. If your child requires medication to be administered whilst they are attending ELC, the medicine must have a prescription label and be accompanied with a medication form that can be collected from your child's key worker.

Similarly, if your child only receives medication at home, it is useful to alert your child's keyworker as it allows them to better support your child whilst in ELC. In

the event that your child becomes unwell whilst in ELC, a member of staff will notify you or your emergency contact. Can we please ask that all parents/carers ensure that these contact details are up to date? Thank you.
