#### Dear Parent/Carer

I hope this finds you and your family keeping safe and well.

Please find out below some key information about the planned return to Carluke High School for August 2020 in line with the guidance outlined by Mr Tony McDaid, Executive Director Education Resources), in his communication 16 June 2020.

#### **Health and Safety**

The health and safety of everyone in Carluke High School remains at the heart of all our plans. Risk assessments and infection control measures have been implemented and will continue to be reviewed in line with Scottish Government and NHS Lanarkshire. Measures that will be in place include:-

- Hand sanitisers at every entrance and in every classroom in the school.
- Additional cleaning routines across the school.
- Clear signage and rules on physical distancing throughout the school building.
- Reduced movement of staff and pupils during the school day.

#### Will teachers and staff be in before pupils to prepare for a safe return?

Teachers and staff have already been in school preparing for the return of pupils in August over the past few weeks. Tuesday 11 August will be an in-service day to enable final preparations and briefing on the latest and most up to date safety procedures from the Scottish Government.

#### When will schools return?

Carluke High school will re-open to pupils on Wednesday 12 August 2020.

Pupils S1 – S6 will be split into two groups. Pupils have been split in alphabetic order of surname to ensure as close to 50% capacity in the school is achieved each day.

You will receive a text message today, **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2020**, confirming which Group your child/children are in.

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Group 1 will return Wednesday 12 August 2020.

Group 2 will return Thursday 13th August 2020.

Friday 14th August 2020 we will have all S1 in school as part of their Transition Programme

Pupils will attend school **5 full days every 2 weeks**. This model is common to all Clydesdale Secondary schools.

Group 1 - 3 days (Monday – Wednesday) Week 1 and 2 days (Thursday – Friday) Week 2

Group 2 - 2 days (Thursday - Friday) Week 1 and 3 days (Monday - Wednesday) Week 2

# What are pupils expected to do the days they are not in school?

Pupils will be supported in their learning at home the days they do not attend school. This approach is known as "blended learning" and is a mix of face to face teaching in the classroom and learning at home. Support will be provided for your son/daughter when they are not in school. Details of this support will be provided when your child returns to school in August by their class teachers. Parents/carers are not expected to take on the role of offering classroom experience at home. With smaller class sizes in almost all areas, teachers and support staff will have the opportunity to set appropriate tasks and work that can be done at home.

We recognise that challenges remain for some families in resourcing home learning. A well-being survey will be issued to all pupils via Google Classroom this week to gauge how they are feeling

about the return to school in August and to provide an opportunity to identify any of these challenges.

#### What will the structure of the school day be for my child at Carluke High School?

The school day will start Monday to Friday for pupils at 8.50am.

Monday to Thursday will be split into 3 sessions and Friday will be split into 2 sessions.

A 15 minute interval will take place in the morning during Session 1/Session 2.

Lunchtime will start at 12.50pm Monday to Thursday and last for 45 minutes.

Monday to Thursday school will finish at 3.35pm and Friday school will finish at 12.30pm.

We recognise there is a very limited stock of school ties currently but every effort is being undertaken by ALJ to ensure these will be available in the coming days. We will liaise with ALJ and update you as to when ties are available and how they will be best distributed.

## What will be the position with school transport in August?

I am not in a position to offer clarity on what this will look like in practice. South Lanarkshire Council is working closely with Strathclyde Passenger Transport and travel contractors to agree safe protocols, in line with government guidance, for pupils who come to school in buses and taxis.

#### What about S1 Transition Days that haven't taken place as normal in May/June?

I appreciate the concerns expressed by parents regarding transition days and them not taking place as normal in June for all our new S1 pupils due to current restrictions. We have run a limited transition programme in consultation with our Primary colleagues for pupils with Additional Support Needs this week led by the schools Learning Support Department.

We will run a transition programme for all S1 pupils in August. This will take place on:-

- Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> August (Group 1)
- Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August (Group 2)
- Friday 14th August (All S1 Group 1 and Group 2)

This will provide all our new pupils with the opportunity to familiarise themselves with their new school.

We are looking forward, as always, to seeing all our pupils and to meeting our new S1 pupils in August.
