It is important that you inform the school why your child is absent for our records. The office opens at 8.30am or you can leave a message at any time on the answer machine.

If you have concerns over your child's health / absence please don't hesitate to make an appointment with Mrs Wood. Attendance is so important for your child's progress and learning. If your child's attendance is below 90% Mrs Wood will be in touch with parent/carers.
