

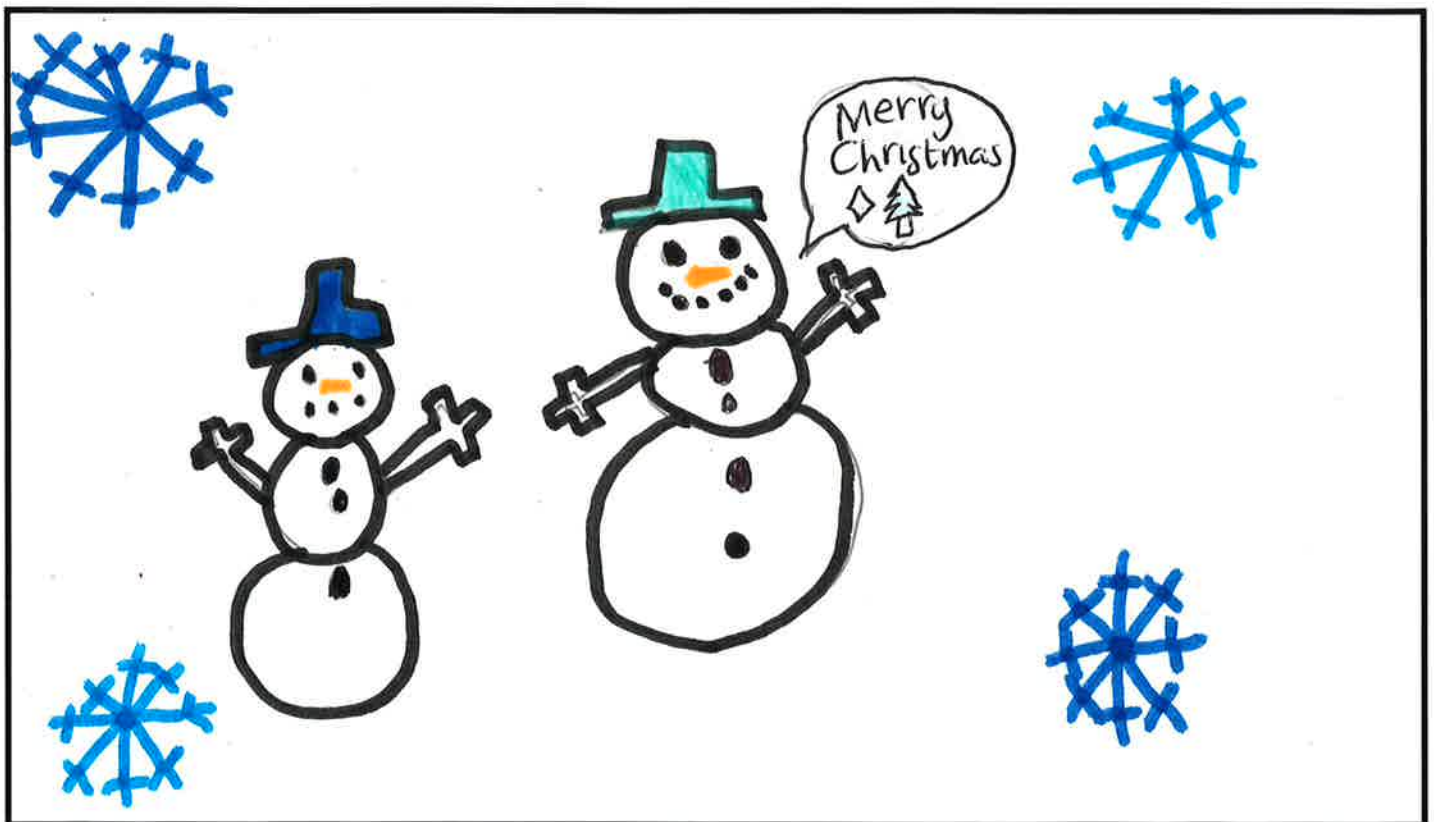

with a hand waving hi!



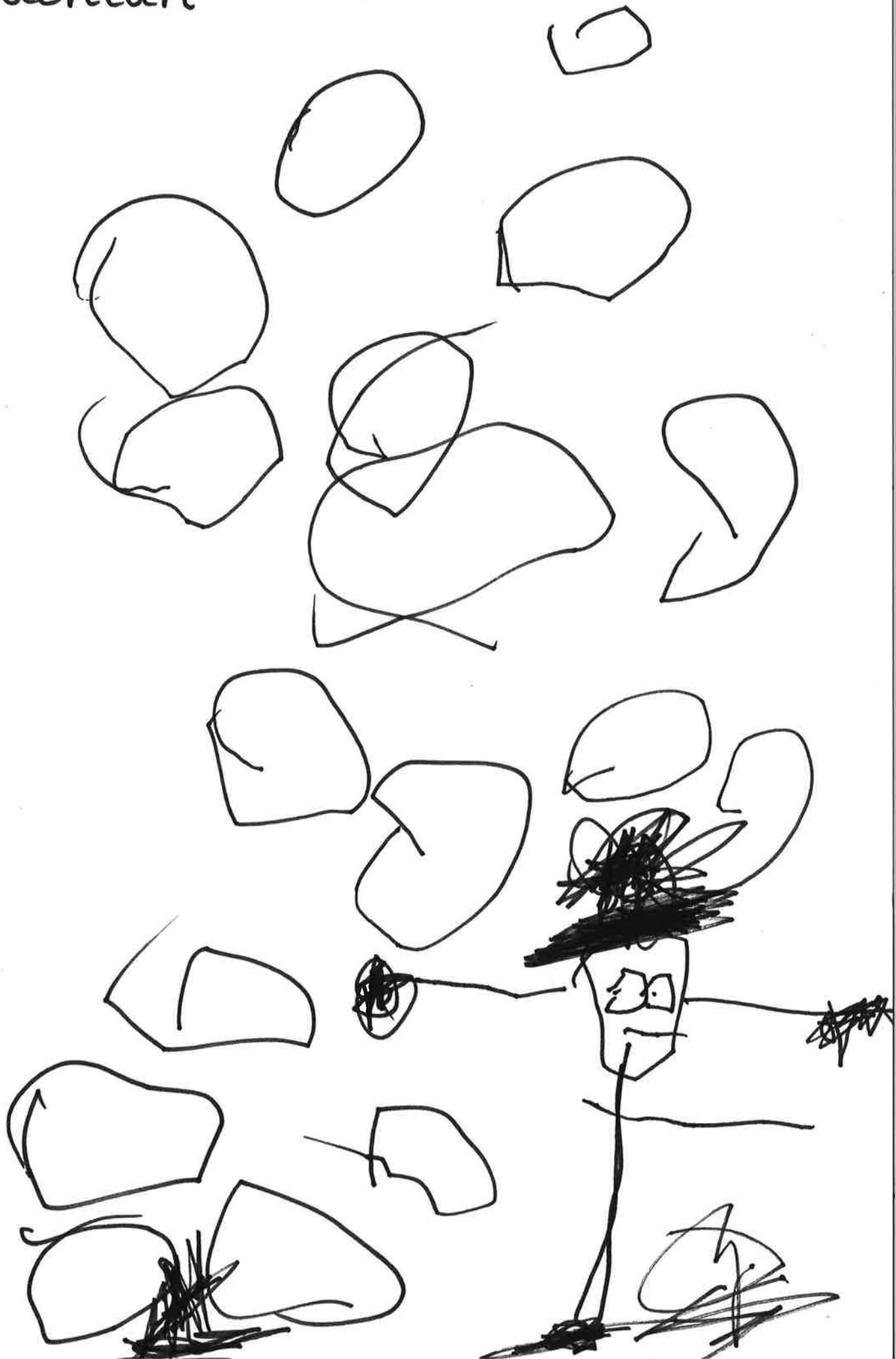
He came in with quite a sigh

Step 1: Firstly put powder in the cup.

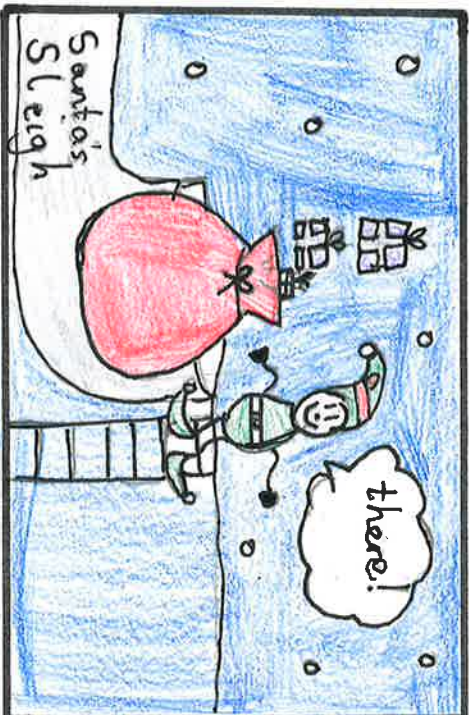
Step 2: Secondly put in the boiling water.

Step 3: Next put in the milk.

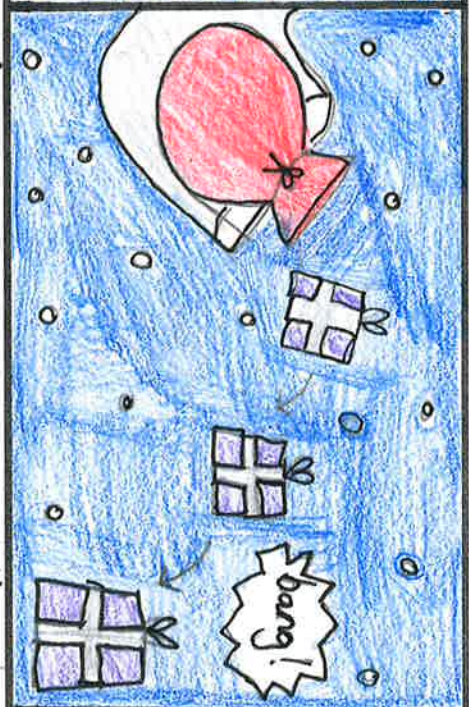
Step 4: Put in the spasm and stir.

Step 5: lastly you can add in marshmallows if you want.

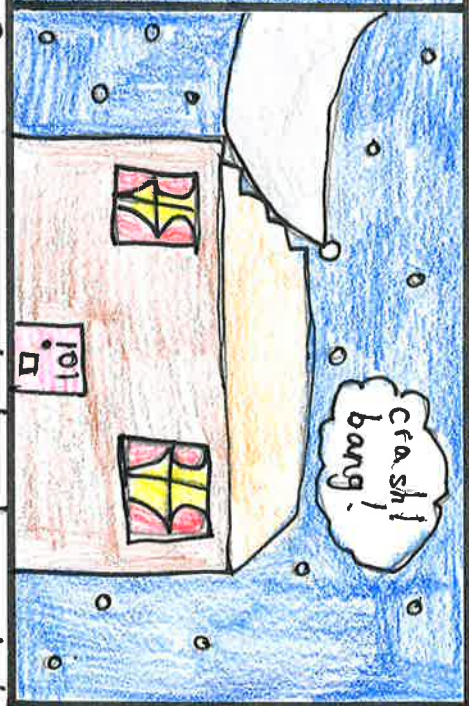
The Christmas Problem



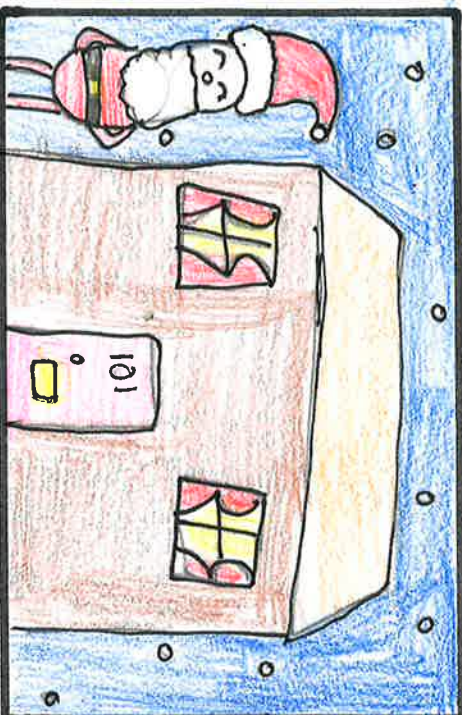
It was a hard working night at the North pole, They elves had just put the last small gift on Santa's sleigh.



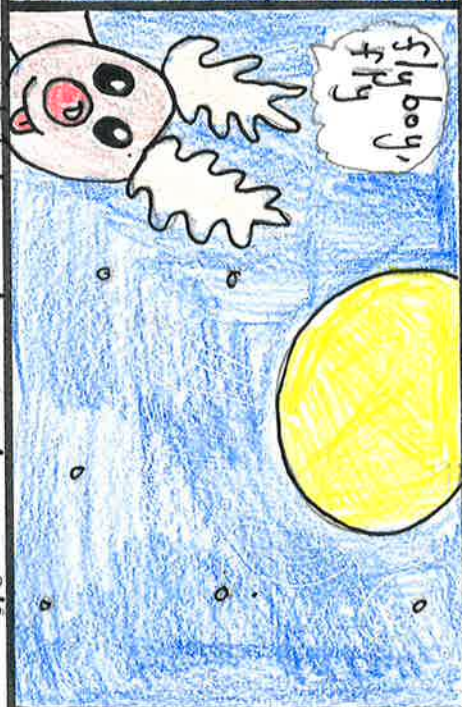
Next santa flies off with all the presents but one had just fallen off. Santa tries to fly back but crashes into a house!
