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*Children should place their Show and Tell Toys in their bags before their parent/carer leaves Nursery and should leave them in their bags until it is Show and Tell time to avoid the toys becoming broken or damaged.

*Transition from Nursery to Primary 1 during May and June: Arrangements are now in place to provide children with an excellent transition programme to support them in moving from Nursery into Primary 1.

Nursery children have already been using many areas of the school during their sessions at nursery and are becoming more familiar with the school (beyond the nursery) every week.

Staff from P1 classes will visit Nursery before pupils begin visits to their proposed Primary 1 settings. The children will be visiting with their key worker and, please note, these groups are not an indication of future classes. These visits will take place within your child's normal nursery sessions.

In addition, children will also be given an opportunity to visit their classes for a longer session towards the end of the term (when the P7 pupils visit High School). Further details of this visit will follow.
