Some of our afterschool and lunchtime clubs have started this term and will continue next term. All children attending our after-school clubs will exit our school building via the High Street gate and children can be collected from the High Street playground. There will be no collection and exit via the Rattray common playground gates. A reminder that as staff give up their free time to run these clubs, these can be cancelled at short notice dependent on staff sickness or other personal reasons, therefore please do not rely on our afterschool clubs as childcare. Our pupil CLIK (Creativity, Learning, Inventiveness and Knowledge) skills sessions are based around life skills which we do not necessarily develop in class time.
