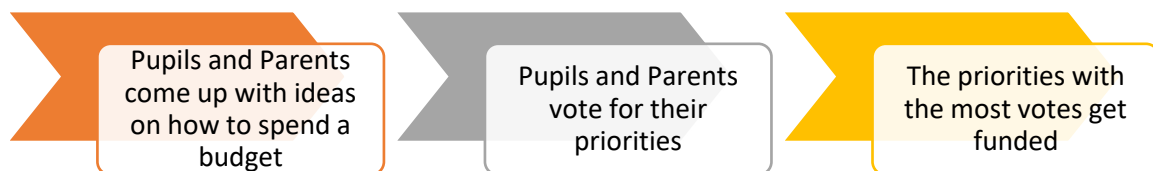




Participatory Budget is a way for people to have a direct say in how local money is spent.
