
### Newsletter: August 2020

#### **Parent Pay**

Parent Pay is the system used across South Lanarkshire to pay for school lunches and activities such as outings. It is important to sign up for a parent pay account as lunches cannot be paid using cash. Currently on 56% of parents have activated an account. #### Cycling to School
