<u>How you can help at home</u>

- Sing songs and rhymes nursery rhymes and Jolly Phonics songs.
- Play rhyming word games.
- Practise sounds with flashcards/letters
- Look for objects to make sound collections

- Count items at home
- Group items such as pasta, buttons in 2s, 3s, up to 6
- Practise writing name using correct letter formation
- Encourage independence when putting on/ taking off coats, shoes, jumpers etc.
