In Maths & Numeracy we will learn to:

- reinforce the times tables to multiply and divide focusing on speed and agility
- use rounding (i) to 10, 100, 1000 (ii) of up to 4 digits
 (iii) of decimal numbers

- use four operations + x ÷ (i) using 3 digit numbers;
 (ii) up to 5/6 digit numbers (iii) with decimal numbers
- use different strategies to solve word problems e.g.
 try a simpler case
- $\circ \;$ understand and use negative numbers
- o investigate 2D shapes e.g. tessellations
- use decimal numbers and link to percentages
- use measure, weight and volume in everyday life e.g.
 (i) know 1000g=1kg (ii) convert between kg and g
- find out about famous mathematicians
