- School discos.
- Indoor / outdoor equipment and toys.

## 7. Principal Teacher Report

Sports kit was discussed, it was agreed that school would provide the Parent Council with the number needed and sizing. Discussion around the type of sports kit, hoodies and joggers was requested and it was agreed that we could provide hoodies which AMK is able to print onto the Burrelton school name. If in the future, it was felt that joggers were still needed we would be happy to look at funding this too. MM will order hoodies and supplies required for AMK to print onto them.

Picnic benches for the playground are still needed. AMK to discuss with Man Shed about providing these and the Parent Council will be funding this.

The Sand Pit it rotten. AMK's husband, Duncan will likely be able to repair or replace this.

### 8. Fundraising:

MM has booked the charity shop again for May 2025.

AM has contacted the farm in Blairgowrie that run the blueberry picking. Advised to contact again in the Spring to book a day for us to fund raise.

### 9. AOB

The Parent Council plan to hold a Christmas disco again this year. Possible sponsors for drinks and snacks provided were discussed and it was queried if LA could discuss with the owner of the village shop, Gary, if he might be able to provide these.

It was agreed that the P7's should have their hoodies as early into the academic year as possible in order for them to get the full use of them. Parent Council are happy to offer £10 towards the cost of each hoody. We require a P7 parent to take this on. The school will email P7 parents to make them aware of this.
