Literacy

- **Spelling-** This will be developed, using a variety of spelling strategies.

- **Writing** - The pupils will be focussing on imaginative writing this term.
- **Handwriting** - Pupils will work on joining their handwriting. They will be expected to transfer this into their daily written work.

This term we will be reading *The Snow-Walker's Son* by Catherine Fisher. We will be discussing use of vocabulary, inference, predictions, explaining, retrieval, and summarising. This is taking place as a class and in small groups.
