The majority of children will be developing skills in:

Number

- Revision of number stories to 10
- Revision of addition and subtraction within 10 through the concept of money
- Mental addition and subtraction within 10
- Problem Solving strategies

Money

- Identifying and using coins up to £2
- Using coins to pay the exact value for items to 10p

Data Analysis

- Collecting, organising, displaying and interpreting data using simple graphs
- Sorting objects/numbers into Carroll diagrams and bar graphs.

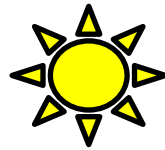

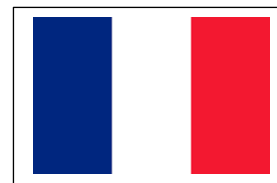

Children will continue developing skills through daily routines in:

- Numbers/Days
- Months of the year

Literacy

Children will be developing skills in:

- **Phonics and Common Words** – These will be developed through using a variety of active spelling strategies.
- **Reading** - books corresponding to their book band. Children will continue to enhance their understanding of the books through comprehension and reading activities.
- **Writing** – they will learn to use VCOP (vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation) to enhance their writing. Children will work on narrative and persuasive writing.
- **Handwriting** – Pupils will work on joining their phonemes weekly and will be expected to transfer their joins into daily writing work.
- **Listening & Talking** – listening to others, giving reasons for ideas and opinions

Minibeasts & Plants



Children will learn to grow plants and name their basic parts. They will be able to talk about how they grow and how to look after them. Children will learn to discuss and observe simple life cycles in the class. They will learn about different living things (minibeasts) linking to plants.
