

Numeracy and Mathematics

We will be working on the following topics in Numeracy, which will be differentiated:

- Place value and number sequences
- Number formation
- Addition to 20/100
- Subtraction to 20/100
- Rounding and estimating

These topics are embedded using concrete materials, ICT games, number lines/squares and mental strategies.

Suggested Homework

The learners in room 2 will be given their reading book home to read every night. We will also issue Giglets passwords so that learners can log into this online reading platform to enjoy interactive books. A weekly word list will be provided to embed the phonemes we are learning. Sumdog log ins will be provided to enable learners to practice their numeracy skills. A homework jotter will be provided. This does not need to be returned to school and is intended to support home learning.

Literacy

- Phonemes and spelling - These will be developed through using a variety of active spelling strategies.
- Reading - The pupils will continue the reading programme in accordance with their book band using Oxford Reading Tree and other banded texts.
- Writing – The Writing focus in Term 1 will be narrative writing. This will include letters, personal stories and diary entries.
- Handwriting - Pupils will work on joining their phonemes weekly and using them in a sentence. Letter formation is practised daily.
- Our French focus for Term 1 will be greetings, numbers to 10 and days of the week.

Health and Wellbeing

- We use health and wellbeing check-ins daily to express how we are feeling.
