- Handwriting - Pupils will practise this each week. They will be expected to transfer this skill into their written work.

French will be incorporated throughout the curriculum each day. This term we will expand vocabulary knowledge of the calendar and classroom objects.

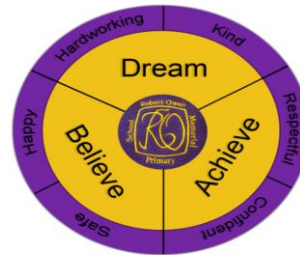
Health and Wellbeing
