Literacy

Pupils will be developing and enhancing:

- *Phonemes and spelling* - These will be developed using a variety of active spelling strategies & activities.
- *Reading* - Continue the reading programme in accordance with their book band.
- *Writing* - Pupils will develop writing for a variety of purposes
- *Handwriting* - Pupils will work on letter formation & joining their phonemes weekly, transferring this into their daily written work.
