

Numeracy and Mathematics

All children will be challenged at a pace appropriate to their learning.

The children will be developing skills in:

- Number recognition and formation to 10.
- Matching number symbol to quantity.
- Counting objects to 10.
- Ordering numbers to 10.
- Understanding the addition stories to 10.
- Counting backwards from 10.
- Recognising the number before/after and more/less than a given number.
- Identifying odd and even numbers.
- Shape, patterns and symmetry.

Learning across the Curriculum

'Under the Sea'

Social Studies and Science

The children will be exploring nature within different environments as they research interesting facts about the creatures that live in seas and oceans.

The children will learn how some sea creatures eat smaller sea creatures to live and which sea creatures can live in the sea and on the land. The children will also learn about the importance of keeping beaches clean, safe and tidy.

Expressive Arts

Art - The children will be experimenting with a variety of materials to create 3D models of sea creatures and an underwater display.

Music – The children will explore percussion instruments that represent sounds of the sea and sea creature movements.

Dance – The children will move in different ways to represent the movements of different sea creatures to relevant music.

Children will be learning skills in:

- Listening
- Turn taking
- Emotions

Literacy

Children will be developing skills in:

- Phonics – learning the name and sound of each letter, blending letters together to make words and correct formation.
- Common words/spelling – to read and spell using active strategies.
- Reading books corresponding to their book band.
- Writing - they will begin to learn that letters make words and words make sentences. They will learn what is needed to construct a sentence i.e. capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. They will learn that 'and' is a connective.
- Rhyming, alliteration and syllables.

Children will be developing skills in:

- Greetings
- Numbers to 10
