- Number recognition 10, 20, 100, 1000, 10000
- Numbers before, after and between
- Number patterns
- 2D and 3D shape

Health and Wellbeing

In PE. the children will be learning about athletics and possession games focusing on their motor skills, sportsmanship, and fitness. We will be continuing the daily mile and would encourage parents to ensure their children have suitable clothing for this i.e., waterproof jacket.

In HWB, Children will be learning about healthy lives. They will also learn about safety – understanding what safety is, assessing the safety of situations and how we can show being safe. We continue to work on understanding our emotion through our Emotion Works programme.
