Accounts update: Current balance is £2896. Cost of Swimming and the bus to get there to come off yet as well as P7 hoodie.

Catriona update:

School Roll

- 4 enrolled for Nursery one doesn't start until Jan. All are split placements though.
- We have 19 p1-7 starting in august. If we had one more, we would HAVE to go to 2 teachers
- If we had 2 classes, we would have a strong argument to have Nursery here linking with the lower class.
- Have had a few enquiries of people interested in sending their children here.
- So next year, we could have Nursery and 2 teachers, or we could be as we are now.

Current Routines

- 2-7 class routines are well-established. Movement of groupings working well.
- Children are getting into a routine well so Ms McTeir is now better able to concentrate on focussed-teaching groups whilst the rest of the class are learning independently.
- Afternoons the class is trying to get a balance of all the other curricular areas.
- New classroom assistant Heather Waddell. Working really well
- We are lucky as additional music has been kept, so we have 2 hours of music a week. P1-4 having the additional music sessions currently
- P4-7 doing European topic currently, ties in with Brexit! Helps them understand what Brexit is all about too. They are engaging with Technology too, through bridge design which ties in maths.
- Going on a trip to the Forth Road Bridge at some point. They have a workshop they run up there. Session runs from 10-2pm. It will be an early start and coming back later. Transport is over £200, would be good if Parent Council could fund this cost. This was given the go-ahead by all present.
- Looking at a possible Planetarium visit later in the year put on by the Royal Observatory £250 costs.

• Emma knows someone who owns a transport company in Jedburgh – will enquire on costs for this and check if they are SBC approved. Tamsin's quotes on this to date have been £260 for the Forth Bridge trip.
