School Improvement

All staff have been busy over the last 2 days getting things ready and engaging in training for the year ahead. Our school improvement priorities this year will be Literacy and Health and Wellbeing. All staff took part in training around Neurodiversity yesterday and we worked on how we will move forward with all our improvements.

In Health and Wellbeing, we will be revisiting our school values and expectations. If we wish standards to be high, it is important to continually revisit and work with the children on what we all need to be doing to ensure we create the best environment possible for all our children to learn and thrive.

Our school values are Kindness, Perseverance, Inclusion and Respect.

This term we will have a large focus on Respectful. We will be revisiting how we expect everyone to be respectful and will be setting expectations high in relation to this. Please support us at home over the next few weeks by asking your children about this and getting them to talk to you about what people need to do to ensure they are respectful to others.

Staffing


