WOW (World of Work) Workshops

P7 will be taking part in 3 virtual workshops in December.

The <u>Virtual Code Art</u> session allows pupils to use coding to create shapes and colours and allows students to program their own artwork while learning basic programming skills and highlight links to digital careers in programming and web design.

The <u>Virtual Cracking Cryptography</u> session teaches pupils about cryptography and use programs to encrypt and decrypt messages while exploring careers in cybersecurity.

The <u>Virtual Games Design</u> session uses Microsoft MakeCode to allow pupils to create their own short video games using similar easy to use visual drag and drop programming to make the game and learn basic programming skills. This allows discussion of the skills they have used and exploring links to relevant computer and digital related careers like but not limited to programming and games design.

Eagle Schools


We are working with the Southern Upland Partnership on their Eagle School program. This focuses on eagle ecology, their place in history and culture and learning how to identify Golden Eagles from other birds of prey. Through an array of cross-curricular activities, students not only gain a knowledge of Golden Eagles but will consider their relationship with the natural world and formulate their own opinions on their place within it.
