Headteachers Report

1. Update on pupils returning to school.

- First Minister will confirm this at her briefing on Tuesday 16th
 February, but as long as things continue to improve as they are
 now, P1-3 will return we have 4 P1-3s. (This briefing will also
 include information on what's happening with regards to P4-7 return
 to school.)
- P1-3 children will be taught in the main classroom, the hub children will be kept separate.
- P4-7 children will continue with online learning. Class teacher will do some online live lessons for P4-7 while the other children are supported by Mrs Waddell.
- Safety procedures will remain in place as before, although there maybe more. Waiting on the guidance coming through.

2. Update on classroom teacher.

- Ms McTeir is moving to a temporary post and might be back after the summer, as the position is temporary.
- Mrs Finn has agreed with the HT of the future school that Ms McTeir will not attend her new post until we know when all the children will be back in class. When this date is set, Ms McTeir will start at the new school on the first day back in order to be able to welcome her new class back.
- The likelihood is that new teacher at Sprouston will start after Easter (as there are lots of checks to do etc). There have been some applicants for this role already.

 Still making plans for high school transition in the final term – unfortunately the residential probably won't go ahead.
