Covid 19

As we come back after what we hope was a lovely Christmas break for you all we return to some of our previous restrictions in school.

Lateral Flow kits are available free from all local pharmacies in Kelso and we would encourage your family to follow Scottish Government advice and use these regularly. All cases that we have had in school so far have been picked up initially on Lateral Flow tests.

We would also encourage you to use these if your child has cold symptoms, just for your own and others peace of mind, prior to sending them to school.

If your child has 1 or more of the main COVID symptoms you must seek a PCR test for them. They cannot return to school without a negative PCR test. This means if they have one of the following; temperature, continuous cough or a loss of taste or smell you need to book a test at a test centre for your child. Your child must remain at home with the rest of the family until the result comes back. Please let school know as soon as the result comes back.

We really appreciate your continued support and vigilance in keeping us safe in school, as we navigate what will no doubt be a tricky few weeks.



Winter Weather

With the weather getting cooler and wetter please ensure that your child comes to school with a warm waterproof coat each day. Hats and gloves would also be a good idea. Unless it is particularly wet, the children will still be learning and playing outside.
