Please see below an outline of the e-Sgoil Senior Phase Easter Study Support programme for 2023.

If you are not aware of e-Sgoil it was launched in 2016 to address teacher shortage in the Western Isles. It has now developed into a nationwide community for online teaching and learning. The vision of e-Sgoil is to expand and enrich the curricular offer for all learners across Scotland. Your child will already have accessed this to support their studies, but this year due to disruption of teachers strikes the offer from them is more comprehensive and an Easter Study Support will run from 3 to 14 April 2023. The programme comprises live, interactive webinars delivered by experienced, GTCS registered teachers from across Scotland.

A total of 80 webinar groups are on offer this year, covering 30 subjects. Each group will meet for three separate webinar sessions.

Last year, there were over 15000 webinar registrations and learners' evaluations were overwhelmingly positive. The service is free to all learners.
