What does it mean to be part of the PLT at Beath High School?

The Prefect Leadership Team are senior pupils who have an important role at Beath.

As a more mature and experienced member of our school community you are generally expected to:

- Set an example to our younger pupils and your peers in terms of behaviour, attitude, attendance and punctuality.
- Respond to pupil and staff requests for assistance and/or advice.
- Represent Beath at events and functions both within and out with the school day.
- Support whole school improvement planning through involvement in different, staff led, improvement groups.

The PLT will:

- Wear their school uniform, including blazer, during the timetabled week and when representing the school at other times. This opportunity should be open to everyone and the cost of a blazer should not be a barrier to anyone.
- Play a full and responsible part in organising prefect duties (e.g. daily duties, parents' evenings, organised events in school, organised events for younger pupils, welcoming visitors to Beath, assisting with classes, assemblies etc.)
- Provide views on whole-school issues.
- Work collaboratively with staff where there are incidents connected with the health, safety or well-being of any individual within our community, or may impact on our school's reputation, ethos etc.

How do I join the PLT?

Firstly, you must consider your own position and decide whether you want to be part of the PLT. Think carefully about the responsibilities and duties alongside the benefits listed above.

The process of selection for 2024/25 will take place over the next two weeks. There will be four stages to selection:

- Application Form
- Group task
- Presentation
- Interview

Any S6 Prefect can complete a PLT application form. Applications will be read and a number of applicants will then be invited to make a presentation. Following the presentations, a group will then be invited to interview. Following the interviews, the PLT will be appointed.

The application form has spaces for two 'referees' (supporters), who should indicate why they think you would make a good member of the Prefect Leadership Team. We would expect one to be a member of staff who knows you well and one to be a fellow pupil.
